



## CITIZENSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

### *Years 5 – 7, Year 9 and Year 11*

#### DESCRIPTION

Sydney Adventist College is offering up to five Citizenship Scholarships to students from Australia who enrol in Years 5 - 7, Year 9 or Year 11 on the Strathfield Campus in 2010. Applications must display leadership skills, excel in at least one area that has contributed to, enhanced and impacted their school campus in a positive way, and demonstrate consistent, sound academic achievement.

The Citizenship Scholarship is worth \$1,200 for one year of study.

Year 11 recipients are nominated by College Administration and are not required to complete an application form. All other applicants must complete the sections below and attach their two most recent school reports (e.g. an applicant applying for a Year 6 scholarship would attach Year 4 final-year and Year 5 mid-year report, an applicant applying for a Year 9 scholarship would attach their Year 7 final-year and Year 8 mid-year reports).

#### CRITERIA

Applicants must complete the sections below and:

1. Demonstrate a sound level of academic success;
2. Demonstrate leadership skills;
3. Demonstrate a significant contribution to school, community, family and/or church.

#### CONDITIONS

1. The scholarship is available to Australian citizens or permanent residents;
2. Applicants must attach copies of their previous *two* school reports which demonstrate sound academic achievement (Y5–9 only);
3. The applicant must provide a description of involvement in leadership, contribution to their school, family, church or community activities which should be attached to the application and countersigned by a supervisor (Year 5 – 9 only);
4. Applicants must provide names and contact details of two referees (Year 5 – 9 only);
5. The scholarship is not transferable and cannot be deferred;
6. The recipient can only receive benefit from one Sydney Adventist College scholarship per year;
7. The value of the scholarship will be applied to the recipient's account and cannot be redeemed for cash, in part or in whole;
8. The recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student on the Strathfield campus;
9. The offer is made subject to all normal admission requirements being met.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS (Year 5 – 9 only)

1. Applicants are required to complete the attached Citizenship Scholarship application form;
2. Applications must be endorsed by an appropriate supervisor such as a teacher, pastor, youth leader, sporting coordinator etc.
3. Applicants must submit with their application, a description of leadership achievements and activities, countersigned by a supervisor;
4. Applicants must submit names and contact details of two referees.

#### AWARD PROCESS

1. Applications close on Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> November 2009. Recipients will be notified within 7 days (new enrolments only);
2. Returning student recipients will be presented with a medallion at Speech Night or at another official function at Sydney Adventist College during the first term of the new school year.
3. Scholarship recipients' names will be published in the Speech Night program;
4. The scholarship will be credited to the recipient's fee account at the commencement of the new school year.
